

Setting Up Your New Email Account

john@sbolnet.com

Outlook should be set to use **your** mail domain as the pop server.

The change is to use your **ISP's** smtp server - and should **authenticate** using their username and password for the email service provided by their **ISP**. Thus they should NOT use their mail domain for sending.

Example:

E-mail Accounts

Internet E-mail Settings (POP3)
Each of these settings are required to get your e-mail account working.

User Information

Server Information

Incoming mail server (POP3): sbolnet.com
Outgoing mail server (SMTP): smtp.vzavenue.verizon.net

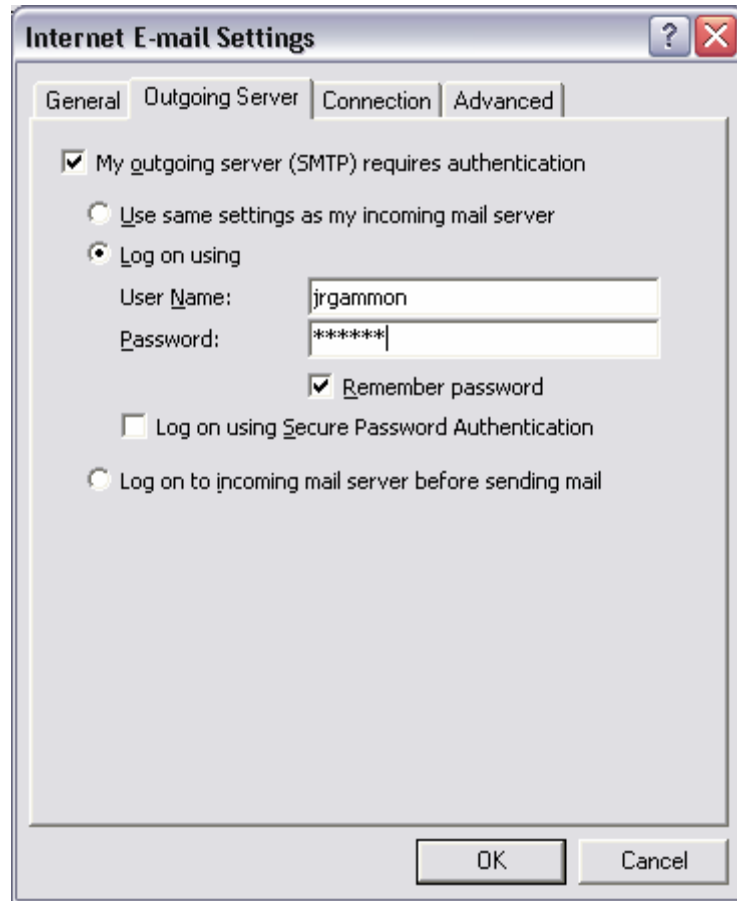
